

# 2025 EVE OF DESTRUCTION - TRAILER RACE RULES

The object of the trailer race is to be the first car with a trailer still attached across the finish line at the end of the race. If the trailer comes off during the race – you will be disqualified.

**DRIVER MUST BE 16 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER.** If you are under the age of 18, you must have a signed and notarized parental permission form on file at the Speedway.

- Upon entering the Trailer Race, drivers and crew members must adhere to proper and sportsmanlike conduct.

**Failure to comply will result in immediate disqualification with no refunds.**

**- NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WILL BE PERMITTED IN THE PIT AREA! DRIVERS AND CREW MEMBERS FOUND WITH ALCHOLIC BEVERAGES WILL BE DISQUALIFIED WITH NO REFUNDS**

1. Open to any 4-Cylinder, V6, V8, Enduro or Demo type car. Any van, SUV, or pickup truck is eligible. No convertibles, no racecars!

2. **DRIVERS MUST WEAR A SNELL RACING HELMET.** Snell racing helmets are designated by orange stickers inside helmet (#SA 2010, #SA 2015 or #SA 2020). **MOTORCYCLE HELMETS ARE NOT CONSIDERED RACING HELMETS AND ARE NOT APPROVED FOR THIS EVENT.** Driver must wear long sleeve shirts, pants and gloves. Fire suit and racing gloves are **HIGHLY** recommended.

3. Car number must be painted or affixed in large bright colors on each side of the tow vehicle and trailer.

4. Drivers only allowed in the vehicle - **NO Passengers- NO Exceptions!**

## **TOW VEHICLES:**

1. All glass, except front windshield, lights and mirrors must be removed. Windshield or screen must be in place. **It is MANDATORY that all interiors be stripped of flammable materials (rugs, headliners, door panels, bottom of rear seat, etc.).**

2. It is **HIGHLY RECOMMENDED** that a wire mesh or a racing type window net be installed over the driver's window opening.

3. **AIR BAGS MUST BE REMOVED.**

4. Battery must be securely fastened with factory holder and covered with rubber mats to stop shorting of battery in case of collision damage.

5. Seat belts must be functional. Racing seat belts are highly recommended.

6. **NO ANTI FREEZE.** Water only in radiator.

## **TRAILERS:**

1. Travel trailers, pop-up campers, boat, or whatever on a trailer is eligible.

2. No extra items allowed for ballast.

3. All Propane and Holding tanks **MUST** be removed prior to coming to the track.

4. Travel trailers will be stripped of flammable items such as rugs, mattresses, couches, tables, curtains etc. All glass must be removed as well as signal lights and chrome.

5. Boats must be strapped to trailer. Nothing loose in hull of boats such as glass rugs, mattresses, couches, tables, curtains etc. must be removed before arrival to track.

6. Pop-ups must be raced in fully extended popped up position. The inside of pop-up trailers will be clean with no extra items. All glass rugs, mattresses, couches, tables, curtains etc. must be removed before arrival to track.

7. Tongue must be attached to tow vehicle by hitch and ball, free pivoting. Safety chains and equalizer bars are not allowed.

8. Mascots, decorating vehicles, advertising nicknames, cartoons, etc. are encouraged. No suggestive language, symbols allowed on vehicles. Anything on the vehicle in bad taste will mean disqualification.

Carnage is welcome but within discretion. Please consider the safety of the fans and other drivers

**Track Officials reserves the right to reject any entry. The decision of the Track Official is FINAL.**

Rules have been posted. It is the responsibility of the competitor to comply. Failure to do so will result in competitors' entry to be illegal and not allowed to run. No refund will be given.
