



Rookie Sportsman Rules

ALL ROOKIE SPORTSMAN WILL FOLLOW SPORTSMAN RULE PACKAGE

**FIRE SUPPRESSION SYSTEM IS MANDATORY.
ALL SYSTEMS MUST MEET OR EXCEED SFI 17.1 SPECIFICATION.**

1. Rookie Sportsman Division opens on 4/15/23. Starting spots will be determined by draw.
2. Remainder of the season all line-ups will be determined by OCFS Handicapping.
3. Heat races will be 6 laps. Feature races will be 12 laps.
4. Any driver who has recorded a Sportsman, Small Block/Big Block Modified win will not be eligible for this division.
5. Season race points based on finish position will be accumulated to determine Rookie Champion.
6. Rookie Sportsman Division is open to anyone who has qualified for 5 or less feature events in any OCFS open wheel division. Rookie eligibility to be determined by Speedway management.
7. All safety and technical rules are outlined in the Sportsman section of the Orange County Fair Speedway Rules.
8. A Sportsman race car can only compete in one class on a given night, Sportsman or Rookie Sportsman. One car cannot compete in both divisions on the same night.
9. 2023 Rookie Champion and/or any Rookie driver winning more than two (2) features must move up to Sportsman for 2024.
10. Rookie Sportsman drivers will be allowed to compete with the Sportsman division on the nights they are not scheduled to race. They will be handicapped to the rear of their races.
