



2018 Eve of Destruction Saturday, September 15th ENDURO RULES

* **DRIVER MUST BE 16 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER.** If you are under the age of 18, you must have a signed and notarized parental permission form on file at the Speedway.

* Upon entering the Enduro drivers and crew members must adhere to proper and sportsmanlike conduct. **Failure to comply will result in immediate disqualification with no refunds.**

* **NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WILL BE PERMITTED IN THE PIT AREA! DRIVERS AND CREW MEMBERS FOUND WITH ALCHOLIC BEVERAGES WILL BE DISQUALIFIED WITH NO REFUNDS**

1. Car number must be painted or affixed in large bright colors on each side of the car.
2. No obscene language or offensive figures painted on car.
3. No pure stocks, street stocks, trucks or SUV's.
4. All exterior glass must be removed before entering the OCFS grounds. Front windshield is optional unless entering in Demolition Derby, then windshield must be removed. All trim, chrome, plastic, etc., including tail lights must be removed
5. Roll bar not required. Up to a four (4) point cage allowed.
6. Stock seat allowed.
7. Drive shafts must be painted white.
8. Two-way radios are not allowed.
9. Driver **must** wear approved regulation helmet and approved seat belt in working order. Long sleeve shirts and pants and gloves are mandatory. Fire suit and gloves are HIGHLY recommended.
10. No altering of suspension. All springs and shocks must be stock. Cars may be asked to run either direction on the track.
11. Only stock steel wheels, maximum of seven (7) inch width.
12. Stock tires only, Tires must be street DOT. Mud and snow tires are not allowed. Same size tires for make of car and same size tires on all four (4) wheels.
13. Gas tank can stay in stock position or can be securely fastened in the trunk. A firewall between the tank and driver is mandatory. Twenty gallons of fuel maximum allowed in tank. Gas lines should run under the car. If the gas line runs through the driver's compartment, it must have a solid secondary containment with solid straps and be securely bolted. No wire or perforated strapping allowed. Cars will not be allowed to race if gas line or tank is leaking.
14. Batteries must remain in the stock location.
15. Driver's door must be welded. Three (3) welds at least three (3) inches apart-front and rear. All other doors, trunk lid and hood must be chained.
16. All hood latches must be disabled. Holes in hood and trunk maybe cut to run chains through. No other holes will be permitted.
17. Stock bumpers for make and model of car only. Must be chained.
18. No transmission, oil, water or power steering type coolers allowed in the driver's compartment. If these lines run through the driver's compartment they must have a secondary containment.

Track Officials reserves the right to reject any entry.

The decision of the Track Official is FINAL.
